## **Guidelines for selection**

### **EMINENT BMCRI ALUMNUS AWARD**

Must be a Graduate or a Postgraduate from BMCRI

Must be a member of the BMCRI Alumni Association. (BMCRIAA)

The awardee should have contributed significantly, in any field, be it teaching, research, private practice, public service, service to BMCRI, GENERALLY ANYONE WHO HAS MADE A DIFFERENCE THE LIVES AND TIMES OF OTHERS, especially in comparison to other BMC alumni, if at all they made any difference at all.

(For example, a popular practitioner, doing dozens of procedure a day or seeing hundreds of patients daily and well known in the community, without any other type of activity for betterment of public life, in areas mentioned below may not be considered. Doing good professional work is common to all alumni and is expected of them. Without the selection criteria mentioned below, thousands may qualify)

Assessment to be made under the following criteria and candidate given a score.

CRITERIA`

SCORE

AGE : Persons past the age of retirement ( 60+yrs) to be considered first in preference to younger persons, everything else being equal.

TEACHING ( In institutions other than BMCRI) & ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS IN HIS / HER

FIELD	Scale of 1-10 pts
ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIVITIES: In professional bodies like IMA, Specialty Societies at local state or national level, BMCRI Alumni Association or the BMCRI Trust .For NRI's similar work in the country of their residence.	Scale of 1-10 pts
In Medical Social Work	Scale of 1-10 pts
In General Social work	Scale of 1-10 pts
Excellence in Arts, Sports, Writing, Speaking, or other non medical talents.	Scale of 1- 10 pts
Substantial financial contribution and / or mobilizing funds or sponsors for BMCRIAA or Trust	Scale of 1- 10 pts
