Students from Bangalore Medical College attended the Basic Skills Course. The programme was well received.

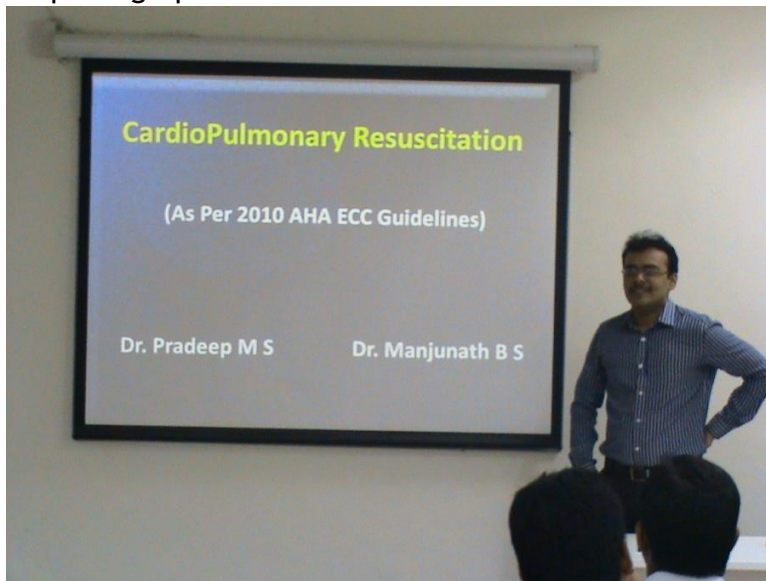
The mentors were;

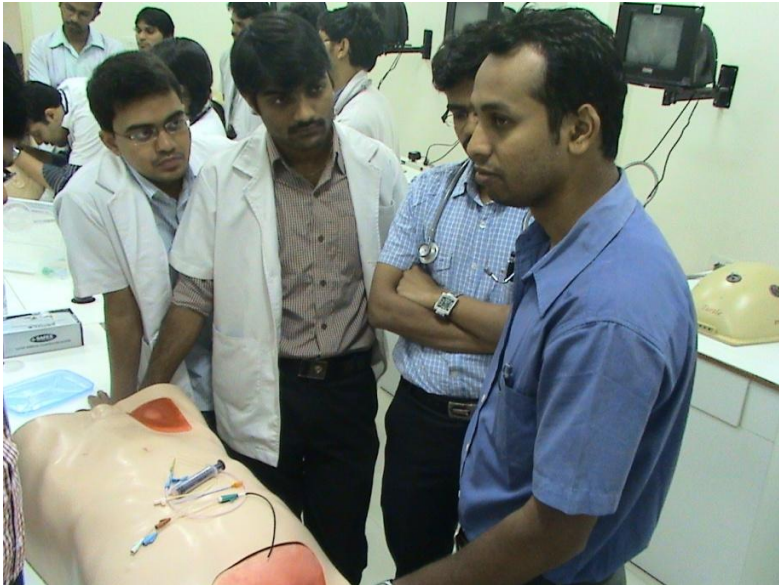
Morning: Dr. Pradeep, Dr. Dhavan, Dr. Adul Razack, Dr. Anand
