Students from Bangalore Medical College attended the Basic Skills Course. The programme was well received.

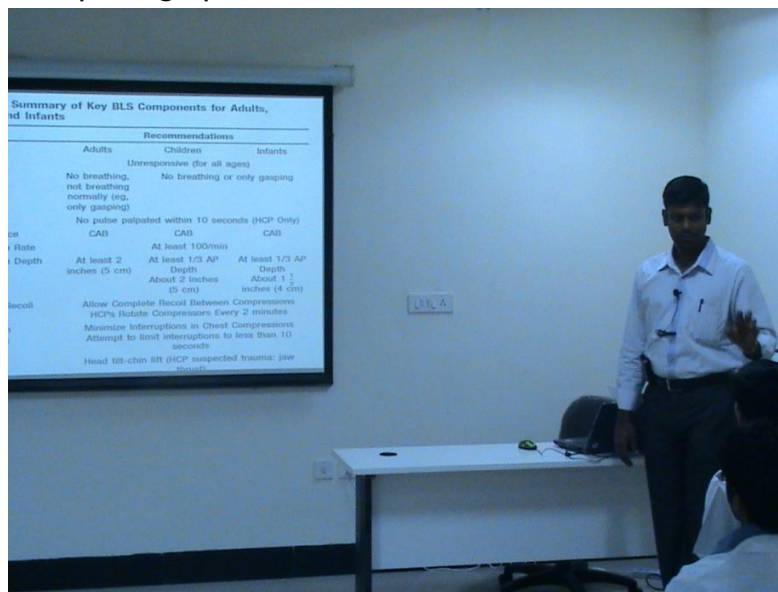
The mentors were;
